

C. diff Caregiver Checklist

Below are resources to support you in caregiving for your loved ones with C. diff infection.

Keep yourself and your loved ones safe

Follow these routines for cleanliness to keep your home safe:

- Hand hygiene.** Wash hands with soap and warm water before and after eating and using the bathroom
- Disinfect and clean thoroughly.** Use products that contain chlorine bleach to kill bacteria; ordinary alcohol-based cleaners or sanitizers do not kill C. diff
- Control contact.** If possible, people with C. diff infection should be isolated in a private room, with a bathroom only they will use
- Protective gear.** Disposable gloves or gowns may be required when visiting hospitalized patients with C. diff infection

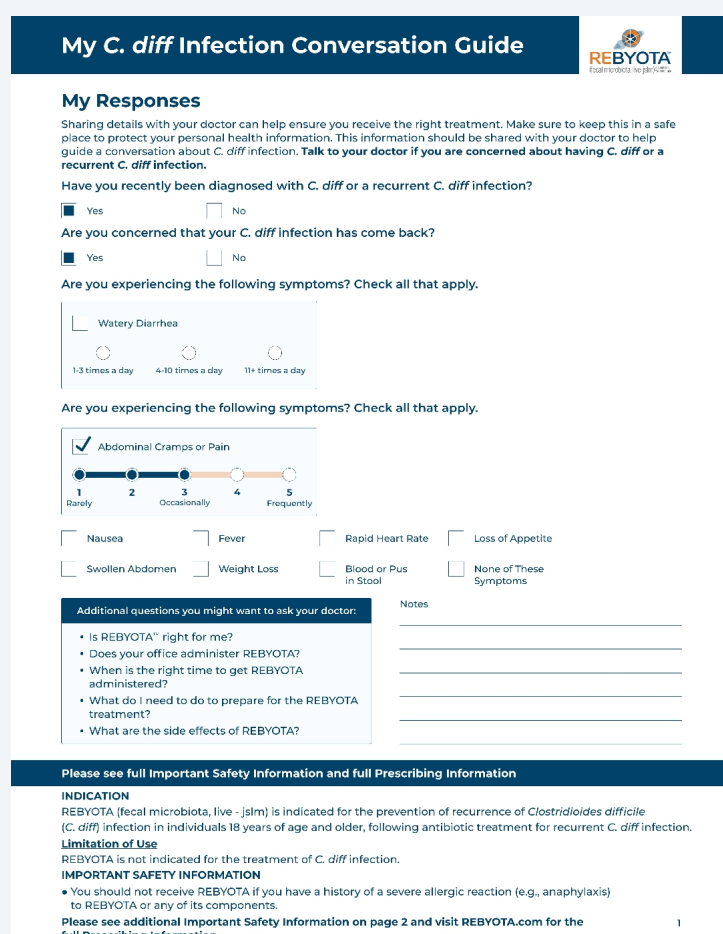
