## C. diff Caregiver Checklist

Below are resources to support you in caregiving for your loved ones with C. diff infection.

### Keep yourself and your loved ones safe

Follow these routines for cleanliness to keep your home safe:

Hand hygiene. Wash hands with soap and warm water before and after eating and using the bathroom
<b>Disinfect and clean thoroughly.</b> Use products that contain chlorine bleach to kill bacteria; ordinary alcoholbased cleaners or sanitizers do not kill <i>C. diff</i>
<b>Control contact.</b> If possible, people with <i>C. diff</i> infection should be isolated in a private room, with a bathroom only they will use
<b>Protective gear.</b> Disposable gloves or gowns may be required when visiting hospitalized patients with <i>C. diff</i> infection
